CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Abstracts (at least one but no more than two full pages) should be prepared using the abstract template and submitted to the Organising Secretariat using the online form (<https://www.sardiniasymposium.it/abstract-form>) no later than **15th February 2019**.

Abstracts must clearly describe the content of presentations and their basis (detailed case study, discussion of experience from practice, preliminary research data, completed research not presented previously, review of literature, administrative initiatives and regulations, etc) and may be submitted for oral or poster presentation. Offers of abstracts for workshops are also welcome.
